### County Road 20 Reconstruction

### Environmental Assessment Study

#### Introduction

The County of Peterborough has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for the reconstruction of County Road 20 from County Road 18 to County Road 23 (approximately 9.5 km). This Study will provide recommendations for staged improvements to the roadway including cross section, intersections, Active Transportation facilities and drainage. The Study will determine if property acquisition is required and consider an interim improvement phase for the project.

#### Study Process

The County Road 20 Reconstruction is being conducted as a Schedule "C" EA Study under the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (2007), as amended in 2015. The Study will complete Phases 1 to 4 of the Class EA Process by establishing the need and justification for the project, considering all reasonable alternatives with acceptable effects on the natural, social and cultural environments, and proactively involving the public.

#### Study Recommendations

Road improvements to be presented include a Special Character Road design for improved safety and the recommendation for the restriction of the link for heavy trucks with diversion to alternate roads.
