

The County of Peterborough has initiated an Environmental Assessment (EA) to study alternatives for the widening of Ward Street in the settlement area of Bridgenorth. The project is being planned as a Schedule 'C' Class EA in accordance with the MCEA. The study area includes Ward Street (CR18) from Champlain Road to the James Gifford Causeway (CR14).




This study is a continuation of the Bridgenorth By-Pass Municipal Class SETTLEMENT OF BRIDGENORT STUDY

The purpose of this study is to develop a recommended plan to provide additional capacity and improve traffic operations within the Ward Street corridor over the study horizon. The project should also address active transportation opportunities in the community and provide space within the corridor for implementation of the Township Community Improvement Plans.
