

Notice of Study Completion Transportation Master Plan Update

About the Study

Peterborough County has completed the **2022 Transportation Master Plan (TMP) Update**. The plan identifies short and long-term improvements to County Roads to serve anticipated growth and enhance roadway safety to the year 2051. It also includes recommended policies to guide the County in decision-making around roadway planning, design, and operation, and to respond to recent trends and emerging issues.

The Study Process

Preparation of the 2022 TMP Update followed Phases 1 and 2 of Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA), an approved process under the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*. The study featured two rounds of public and stakeholder engagement and a series of meetings with First Nations communities and a Steering Committee appointed by County Council to obtain input into the plan. Comments received throughout this process helped shape the report and its recommended actions.

Consistent with the Master Planning Process (Approach 1) set out in the Municipal Class EA, the County completed the 2022 TMP Update at a broad level of assessment. The County will undertake more detailed studies for the recommended Schedule C projects at a subsequent date to fulfil the remaining phases of the Municipal Class EA planning and design process. The 2022 TMP Update will support these investigations.

Notice of Review Period
